Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Mansfield Council on Aging Senior Center in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Mansfield, located at 6 Park Row, Mansfield, MA 02048. The funding would be used to demolish a former police station and, in its place, construct a standalone Senior Center to house the community's Council on Aging (COA). The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the new facility would house the COA's staff while creating a new, purpose-built programmatic space for Mansfield's senior population. Additionally, this facility shall serve as a regional hub for emergency warming/cooling needs as well as an emergency food/supply collection and distribution center that fills an existing service gap.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(1), 5305(a)(2), 5305(a)(4), and/or 5305(a)(5).
