I am requesting funding for Route 6 Corridor Sewer Collection System Phase II in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is located at 81 Main Street, Swansea, MA, 02777. The funding would be used for the interconnection from the Swansea Town boundary to the Town of Somerset's existing Lees River Pump Station. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will support the construction of infrastructure vital to ensuring sufficient capacity of source water, and effective treatment of safe drinking water for 95 percent of the Town of Swansea's residents.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Title VI of the Clean Water Act, 33 U.S.C 1381 et seq..
