I am requesting funding for "Bellingham Department of Public Works PFAS Treatment Project" in fiscal year 2024.

The entity to receive funding for this project is Town of Bellingham, located at Bellingham Municipal Center, Bellingham, MA, 02019.

The funding would be used to construct a treatment system for the removal of PFAS at the Hartford Avenue Water Treatment Plants.
